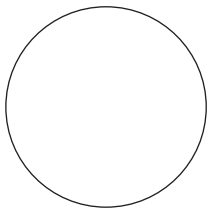

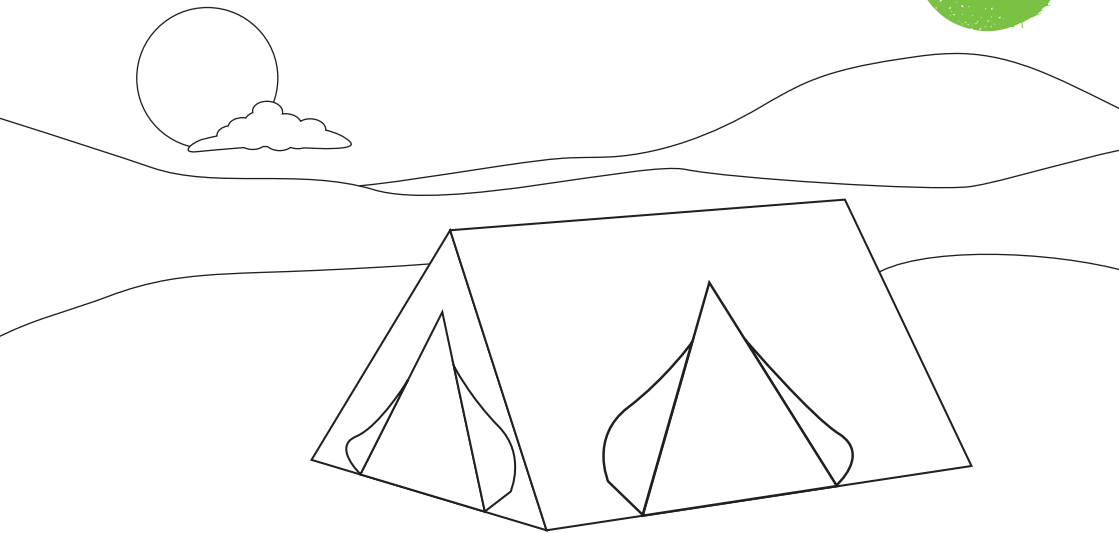
BACKGROUND

This Shabbos Project, we read the portion of Vayeira. Abraham, age 99, is recovering from his *bris* (circumcision). He's in a lot of pain.
